We did not arrive at these rods overnight. Much field work and practical fishing was necessary before the final format was agreed. The results in fish caught - very satisfying. Like their predecessors and contemporaries, tried and tested and not found wanting. The significant lightness has been achieved without loss of power or control. The built-in solid carbon tip gives the same protection in the FIVE rods - bottoms down to 8ozs - running lines to 4lbs. The tighter action does mean a more accurate casting, faster pick up, contact and hook setting. Great experience in rod design and manufacture, hand built from

Current and/or distance make for heavier floating and heavier lines. Lines of 4-6 lbs are well matched to the power of this rod but the compound taper construction, an integral feature of Bruce and Walker rod making, allows lighter lines and tackle to be used on those 'shy' days when running lines as low as 11/4th are needed
