line unquestionably easier than with a nine-footer. While it has enough through-action to make casting pleasantly smooth, there's plenty of accuracy for dry-fly fishing. The rod tip is firm enough to drive larger sea trout hooks firmly home, but without a jarring effect (see Introduction: Materials). So fine leaders can safely be used. NEW ERA gives plenty of sport with school sea trout, thanks to its action and lightness,

but has power enough to take on grilse and large sea trout with ease.
